Design Guidelines for Hillside at Stony Creek for portable basketball hoops during the summer months

The board of directors for the Hillside at Stony Creek Subdivision sought homeowner feedback on the issue and based on this feedback the board of directors unanimously passed and adopted the new guideline for portable basketball hoops.

- Only one goal per lot is allowed.
- •Portable basketball hoops will be allowed to be placed in the front of the house and must be placed on the half of the driveway or as close to the house as possible when not in use during the summer months*.
- Portable basketball hoops must be placed either inside a garage or behind a fence when not in use during the winter months**.
- County noise ordinance **must** be followed.
- Repeated violations and complaints may be grounds for fines levied against the owner of that Lot.
- Portable basketball hoops <u>must</u> be kept in good repair. If broken or damaged, it must be removed until replaced or repaired (this includes but not limited to backboards, paint, netting and base.)

*Summer months are defined as Memorial Day through Labor Day. **Winter months are defined as the day after Labor Day until the day before Memorial Day.
